Definitions

'Student' refers to the person who has created the artwork

'Teacher' refers to the Students School Teacher

'Parent/Guardian' refers to the Students legal parent or guardian

'Adelaide Fringe Schools Poster Competition' refers to the competition dates 26 July - 3 September 2021

Entering the Schools Poster Competition

- By submitting an entry to the Adelaide Fringe Schools Poster Competition, you signify acceptance of all of the terms and conditions outlined here without exception.
- Submission numbers are uncapped and Students may submit more than one entry.
- Entries must be received, uploaded or postmarked by 11:59pm, Friday 3 September 2021.
- Entries submitted by the Students' teacher must:
 - o Include the Student's name, year level and school
 - The Teacher's name and contact details;
 - o and acknowledge that they have or will notify the Parent/Guardian of the Student
- Entries submitted by the students' Parent/Guardian must:
 - o Include: the Student's name, year level and school
 - The Parent/Guardian's name and contact details
 - The Teacher's name and school email address;
 - And acknowledge that they have or will notify the Teacher
- Submission's via Post or Hand Delivery:
 - Entries via post and hand delivery must be submitted with a hard copy application

- Adelaide Fringe will accept digital copies of artwork A4 or A3 colour scan or photo. However, the Student may be asked to provide the original artwork as a condition of winning.
- **Submissions via Digital Application**
 - Digital entries must include the students name in the image file name.
- Entries into the Adelaide Fringe Schools Poster Competition are unable to be returned to the Student. Adelaide Fringe encourages photo and colour scanned copies for submission.

Withdrawing and Disqualification

- Parent/Guardian or Teacher may request that an entry be withdrawn from the competition at any time prior to the announcement of the winning poster. Requests for withdrawal must be submitted in writing to Schools@adelaidefringe.com.au and be accompanied with the Students information. Principal Partner
- Incomplete information may cause the entry to be disqualified.







• Breach of Terms and Conditions will cause the entry to be disqualified.

Winning Entry

- The judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The winning Student will be formalised upon the Students Parent/Guardian and Teacher signing of the Official Poster release forms.
- The Parent/Guardian on behalf of the Student (winning entry) shall assign to Adelaide Fringe in perpetuity all copyright in the image that is selected as the winning entry.
- The Parent/Guardian on behalf of the Student (winning entry) must warrant that they own the copyright in the image and/or parts that comprise the image and are able to unimpededly assign copyright in full to Adelaide Fringe.
- Adelaide Fringe may at its absolute discretion use part of, or the entire image for any purpose and in any form or manner but principally, for the cover of the 2022 Schools Booking Guide.

Adelaide Fringe Schools Poster Competition Prize

- The winning Student will receive an excursion to Adelaide Fringe for their class including;
 - A maximum of 30 tickets to an Adelaide Fringe 2022 show for use by the Students' class and associated teachers up to the value of \$1,000
